Dear St Mary's and Assumption Parishioners,

A blessed Holy Week to you all. I am really looking forward to it. It is an exciting weekend with the reopening of Bone Creek Museum festivities and the Masters to lead into it. Palm Sunday allows us to enter into the spirit of Christ's passion.

Sunday afternoon there are the Communal Penance Services at parishes in Butler Co. With five priests here at 4 p.m. it is a good chance to make your Lenten confession. We have all had temptations, like Christ during his forty days in the desert. We need the grace of the sacrament to be renewed and strengthened for our daily walk.

- 4. Mark 15:34 "My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?"
- 5. John 19:28 "I thirst."
- 6. John 19:30 "It is finished."
- 7. Luke 23:46 "Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit."
