OLD BUSINESS –

Soup Supper – A financial report summary was inserted in the bulletin a few weeks ago for parishioners to read. Profit was higher this year than last...raffle ticket profit was down compared to previous year (\$2,115 vs \$1,450 net)...may consider changing raffle ticket prices for next year.

Roof – Discussed repair versus replacing the roof. Looked at bids from several years ago to get idea on pricing. Jerome and 1 or 2 other men will look at the roof to determine if it needs to be repainted or if the whole roof needs to be replaced. Once that decision has been made then we will start the process of getting quotes and having a parish meeting.

NEW BUSINESS –

Soup Supper – Will be January 31, 2021 if the auditorium is available. Jerome Anzel will check on auditorium availability and if available then after next meeting we will notify Aquinas so it can get on next years' school calendar.

Bank Accounts – St. Mary's is switching to Bank of the Valley. Monthly fees were high at US Bank. After brief discussion it was agreed upon by council that Appleton and Appleton PCCW will switch their accounts over as well for consistency purposes.

Corona Virus – Priest may elect to skip shaking hands but its up to parishioners to decide. Priest will try to remember to make announcement at mass next week.

Door Unlocked – Front door has been unlocked. Will have an announcement in church and also in the bulletin reminding parish to lock up; otherwise, may consider hiding key and limit keys access to select parishioners.

PCCW –

Bingo – Will now host Bingo 2 times a year (used to be 4). It's been hard to get volunteers to work it when so many ladies in our parish work.

Easter Lilies – Order has been placed and we are accepting donations in memory of deceased.

Organ – Lori Sabata will put up sign to see if anyone wants it; otherwise, will disassemble the organ to throw it away.
