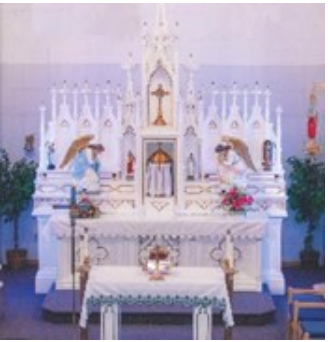

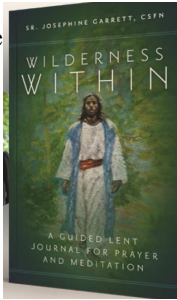
**Butler County Right to Life** meeting will be held on Monday, Jan. 27 at 7pm in the Didier Room. All are welcome.

**Pastor's Corner**

Dear St Mary's and Appleton parishioners,

Regarding our **Honoring our Past, Securing our Future**, we have had a few nice gifts and a couple phones calls come in but still have a long way to go with our \$200,000 challenge match for our Capital Campaign. It looks like we have one week left to try and capitalize on the match. I am praying that we don't leave any on the table.

It has been an exciting week with the Presidential inauguration and BCS Championship game on Monday. I watched about half of both of them. The inauguration and related current events has significant historical impact. There are lots of changes with the executive orders, new cabinet members being interviewed and confirmed. It is interesting to read the executive orders. I am glad the president is more forthcoming with interviews and information than some previous administrations.

I am not very good at politics. Most of my siblings are much better at understanding and following things. My family texts about various aspects but usually with humor to not get too serious and ruffle feathers on the opposing sides.

Also, for your calendars, on Wednesday, July 2, 2025 we will celebrate our parish church dedication with a Solemn Mass at 5:30 followed by a meal, games, music etc. for all ages. Please stay tuned. The Fundraising will help host the event.
