I spoke with a friendly retired gentleman who promotes SA and is willing to help answer questions about the program. His name is Gus and his number is 402-770-2272.

This week has been **busier** with school back in session, Parish Council, Aquinas Finance meeting, etc. I am also preparing for my aunt's funeral in KC on Saturday, the faculty party Saturday night etc.

My aunt and Godmother Carol Shaughnessy Miller died at age of 89. She was the last of her generation in my family. He brother died in 1978 from cancer. My mother and other aunt lived into late 80s. Carol and Bob Miller were the ones who welcomed the Aquinas students to stay at their home on our World of Fun, Royals (Oceans, Truman museum, Nelson Art Gallary, Gates BBQ etc) trips.

She had an amazing charism for hospitality. She always said, "sure you can bring a bus load as long as they behave". They even said, if we are not here, you can still come and stay. We had minor problems like clogged toilets, overflowing jacuzzi, and one kid who climbed out the basement window during the night for some reason (he could have walked out any one of three doors). We enjoyed their game rooms, basketball hoops, breakfasts and morning Mass outdoors on the patio.

Carol and Bob had a house built for entertaining and they did that for all kinds of Catholic groups. With New Year Eve, Easter, Serra Club, and all kind of family gatherings, it was normal for them to host 50-100 people for meals and socials. Their door was literally always open. Carol got into the travel business because she loved to travel (in her blood from parents). She went on a dozen pilgrimages to Medjugorje in Croatia where the Marian apparitions. In her living room, she had a collection of over 50 Marian icons from world travels.

I was blessed to go to the Holy Land with her and Bob, seven priests and my parents, a group of 40 in January 2000. It was a trip for my lifetime. I will really miss Aunt Carol and was blessed to see her at Christmas and have a nice visit at Thanksgiving with her. God bless you all, FBC
