

## Assistant Pastor's Corner:

Dear Parishioners,

In the Gospels, there are many accounts of Jesus going off in solitude to be alone for various reasons. He seeks solitude to prepare for a major task. After Jesus was baptized He spent 40 days praying in the wilderness. After this He was tempted by Satan and then began His public ministry (Lk 4:1-2, 14-15). He seeks solitude to work through grief. After Jesus learned that his cousin John the Baptist had been beheaded, He went away by Himself. Yes, even the Son of God grieves (Mt 14:1-13). He seeks solitude before making an important decision. Early in His ministry Jesus spent the whole night alone in prayer. The next day He chose his 12 disciples (Lk 6:12-13). And there are many other times the Gospels mention that in Jesus' ministry He spent time in prayer, and it was in solitude that he did this.

With only a little over a week into this Lenten journey, I think it is good to remind ourselves that this season of preparation is a time to be renewed to our relationship with God. Each year, the Church gives us this time of Lent to evaluate how things are going. What spiritual activities which were bearing fruit in my life have slipped from my daily schedules? What are the vices that have crept back into my life? Where has my patience and charity started to dwindle and become replaced with harshness and coldness of heart? Lent is a great opportunity to get picked back up when we feel we have been knocked down on this, sometimes, bumpy road of discipleship.

This Lent, I encourage you to allow God to pick you back up in solitude. Find a way to get away to be with Him. That does not mean you need to find yourself miles from another human being. It simply means carving out a little time, perhaps 30, 15, 10, or even just 5 minutes a day to get away from the chaos of life and be with God in silence. Share the burdens of life, the joys of the day, or the dreams for our future with Him. Let's make this Lent one in which we follow the example of Christ and seek solitude to renew and strengthen our relationship with our Father. Maybe you need a more concrete challenge or invitation. Okay, here is one! Join us this Wednesday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, for a praise and worship Eucharistic Holy Hour with solemn reposition and benediction from 6:15-7:15pm. Perhaps this can be an opportunity for solitude this week, solitude in which you encounter the Father's love. May God bless you in this Holy Lenten season.
