Pastor's Corner

Dear St. Mary's parishioners,

Thanks to all who made their pledge to Charity and Stewardship Appeal last week. We are off to a good start with 135 pledges totaling \$38,295. Also, thanks to those who helped set up, bring breakfast foods and assist with the cards. We will have the cards available in the gym this weekend. If you did not fill one out last weekend, please do so this weekend.

Saturday morning May 4th at 9:30 a.m. we need help putting new mulch around the Church and back of the rectory. It shouldn't take more than one hour with rakes and wheelbarrows.

We are honoring the Senior graduates this weekend after the 10 a.m. Sunday Mass and also coffee and rolls and bake sale. May God bless you all as you matriculate onto College or other plans. These are wonderful years in your life and God is with you every step. Stay close to God, your faith, family and friends.

I received the results of the Feasibility Study on Monday. I reviewed them with our Finance Committee on Tuesday and will get them to everyone by next week.

The Gospel is one I love and that I used to teach to the 5th graders at St. Mary's years ago. I was flattered and touched when one of them went on to get married and asked me to do the wedding. When I saw she had chosen John 15:9-17 as the Gospel for her wedding, I asked her why and she said because she learned it by heart in 5th grade.

In it Jesus says "You are my friends **IF** you do what I command you to do." Sometimes we forget the second part of the agreement. We may forget to live by the Ten Commandments (or the great commandment of LOVE). We may violate the Sabbath by working or not attending Mass. We might use God's name or practice false worship of materialism. We could fall prey to lust or have sex outside of marriage. We might say untrue things about another or tell lies. Further Jesus says "it was you who chose me but I who chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit." Jesus chose you in your vocation to bear fruit, to make a difference in his vineyard by staying close to the Vine.

I am finishing a good book given to me by a parishioner called "The Lost Art of Sacrifice - A spiritual guide for denying yourself, embracing the cross and finding joy" by Vicki Burbach (Sophia Press 2021). It is meaningful to exchange good spiritual reading. Please check out a book in the narthex parish library.

This Thursday I am going to NYC for a special nephew's wedding (older bro Keith's #4/5 to be married, named Patrick, the one I gave my kidney to). While there, I will stay with a Polish friend from the seminary (I went to St Joseph's just outside NYC for four years). Some of my NY Archdiocesan classmates are getting together with me on their 35th anniversary of ordination on May 13. It will be a great joy to attend all these celebrations. I will pray for you especially at the beautiful St. Patrick's Cathedral and each day, returning on Tuesday, May 14.
