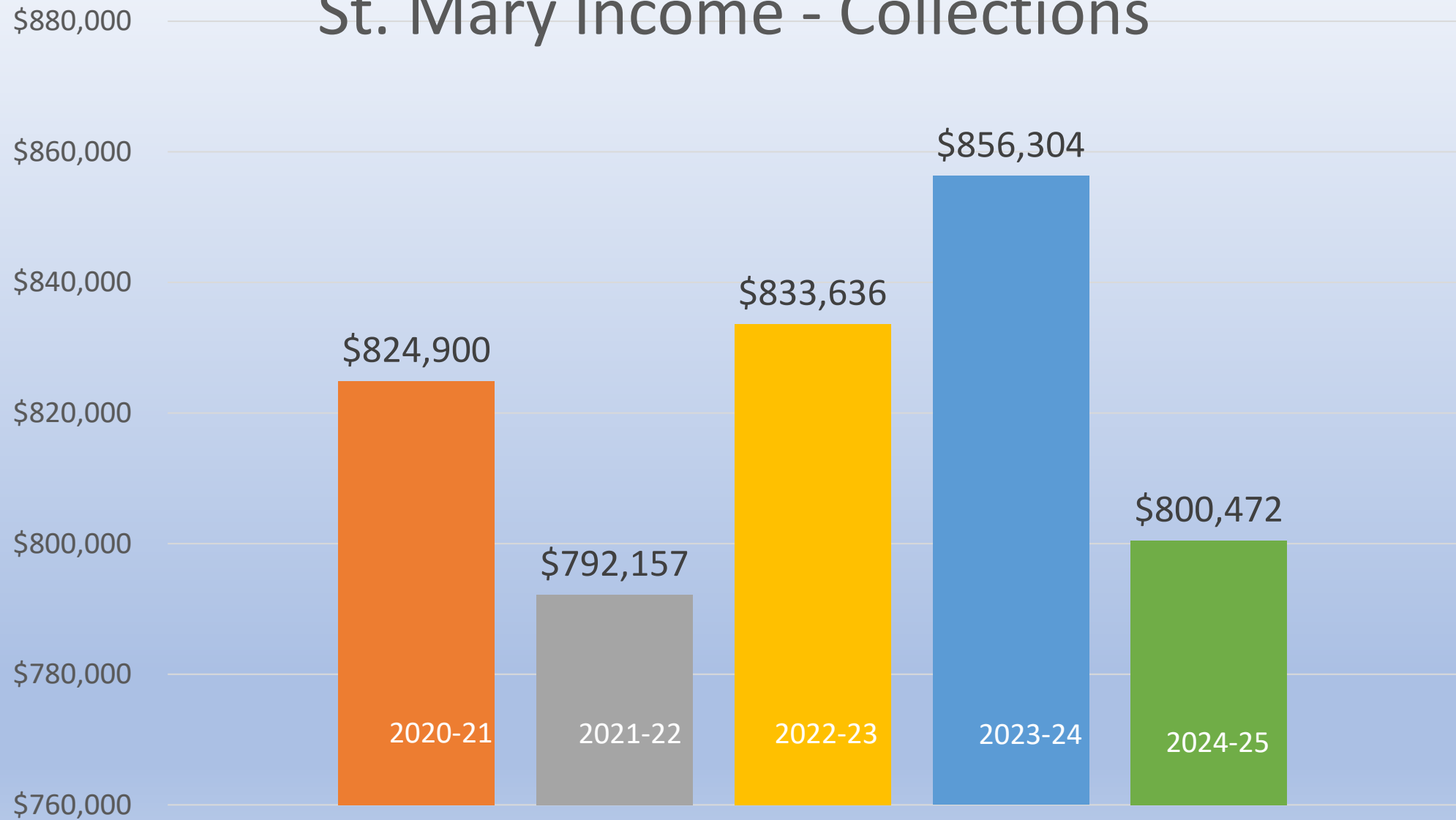

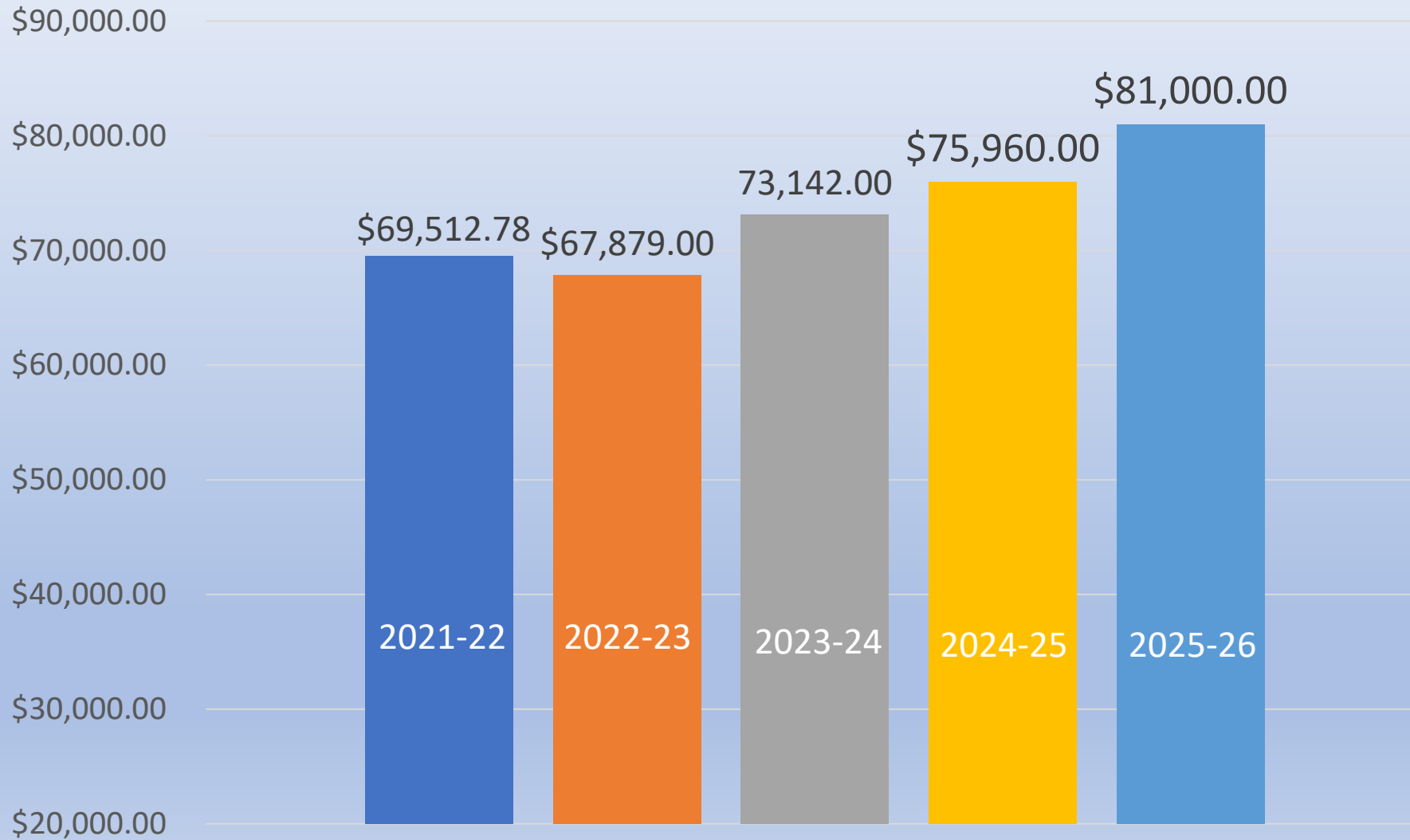


# St. Mary Endowment Income



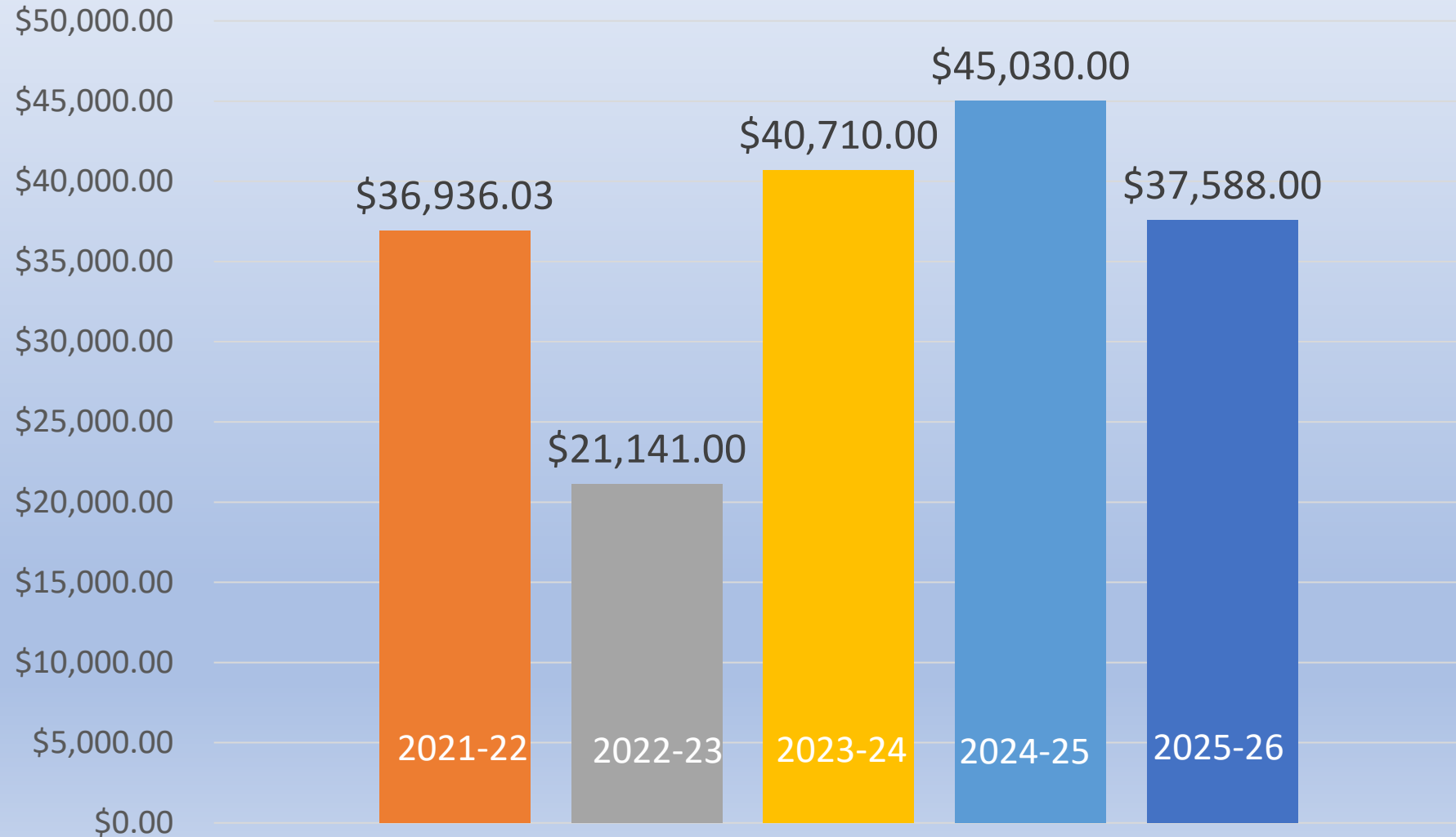

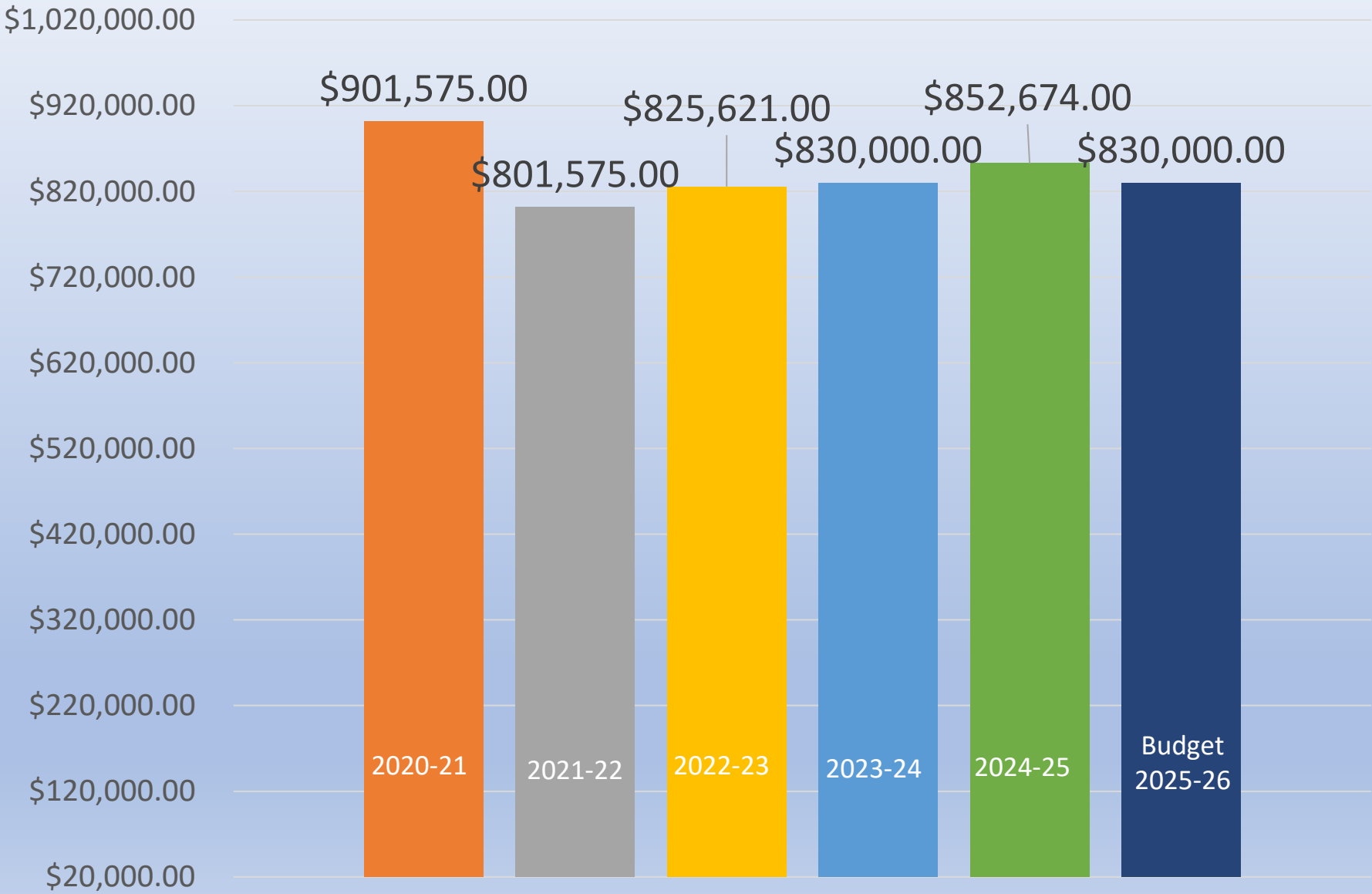

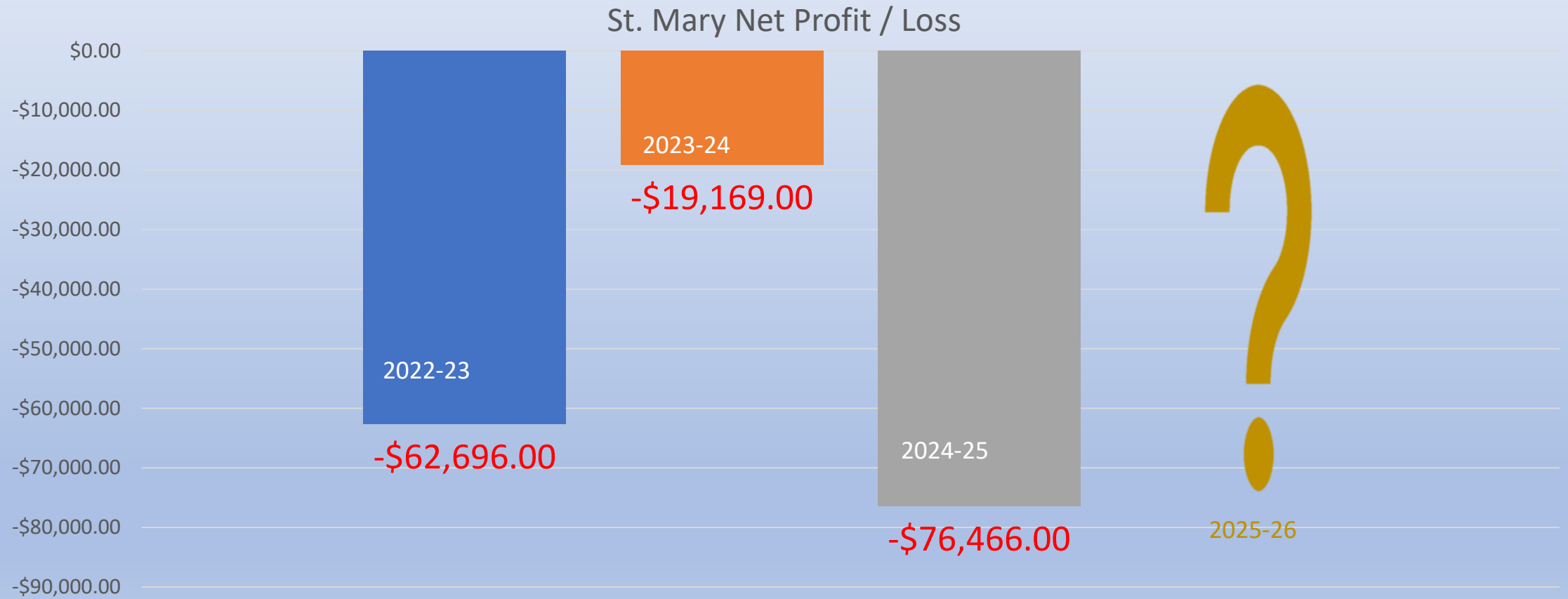

Tremendous success thanks to pledges from  
240 parishioners

(50% of our families)

We have received \$710K in pledges

We have paid off the Bishop \$130K

We have paid off 1/3 of debt to Aquinas  
(\$90K)

Fund

We have used \$135K in funds to allow our  
parish bank account to cash flow
