#### **Assistant Pastor's Corner**

Dear St. Mary's/Assumption Parishes:

Within the last few days I have experienced something I have not in a while...cool, crisp mornings. Maybe it is just a fluke, but the upcoming weather forecast seems to indicate otherwise. I mention all this to simply point out that fall is approaching, meaning we are most certainly entering more deeply into this time we call the "school year" or for those without any ties to a school schedule, we might simply call it the non-summer schedule.

I think the school year/non-summer schedule comes with some

great opportunities...which we sometimes do not take advantage of

in our daily living. Whether it is at school, in the community, in our family, or at the parish, there are simply more things going on. And I think that if we are honest with ourselves, we can find ourselves responding some of these things saying, "I would love to go to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, but I don't have time." "I think it would be really good to spend more time doing \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, but I don't have time." "I feel like it would be beneficial for my spiritual life to \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, but I don't have time." But the reality those of statements, are that they are not true, or at least not completely

I look around and hear people making these claims. I hear my students making similar statements. And most alarming, I find my-self making these comments. But the truth is that our perception of the "time we have" really isn't the issue. If we are honest with ourselves, we will find it is more accurately an issue of priorities. I will never forget when a teacher I had my freshman year of college responded to one of the students claiming they didn't have time. She said, "You have time, you have no less time than anyone else. In fact, time is maybe the only resource that each person has the same amount of as every other person, 24 hours a day. So, no. You have the time, but it just isn't a priority." That comment has stuck with me ever since.

My challenge to you is to dig deeper when a good opportunity presents itself to you that you "don't have time for." Ask yourself, "where do you spend your time?" I imagine a lot of your time is spent on good things. You dedicate time to the needs or your family, your school work, your career, therapeutic hobbies, etc. But is that all of your time? Or is there needless or excessive work that takes up time? Is there too much entertainment and television in your life? Are you dedicating too much time to activities or sports? Perhaps by asking these questions we might begin to see that it is not so much that there isn't time in our days, but that our priorities need adjusted to carve out the time. May God bless you in these days of opportunities, so that you might better prioritize the various activities of your life so that you might make the best use of your time.
