Assistant Pastor's Corner

Dear St Mary's and Assumption Parishioners,

And just like that we are in the full swing of spring! Everything is green and out of dormancy, things are blooming, and pollen is in the air. This is a time of much change. (It even is in the Church having our new Pope! Keep praying for Pope Leo XIV as he begins his pontificate.) Our seniors are finishing up their time in high school and excited about what next year has in store for them. We have some couples and families preparing and eagerly awaiting marriage celebrations. On a personal note, I feel as though it is a time of much change as we are wrapping up the school year, CCD, OCIA, spring landscape work, and wrapping up loose ends here as I prepare to finish my last month at St. Mary's. On the other hand, I am beginning to get an understanding of what my next parish assignment will entail, start my work to help participate with Biking for Babies this summer again, and figure out what I will be teaching at Pius X in Lincoln. Needless to say, I feel as though there is much transition in my life right now.

I look forward to this last month of my current assignment receiving all that God desires for me in it.
