

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear St Mary and Assumption Parishioners,

Many thanks to those who came out for the day of retreat with Fr. Coulter last Saturday. I was there for some of it and we had about 30 attend to learn more about praying with scripture in Lectio Divina style. As the director of the Retreat House, he is skilled at helping people to grow in their prayer lives and techniques. Having good attendance shows that we care about prayer.

This weekend we kick off our Bishop's Appeal for Vocations. We will have two seminarians from our parishes come to speak: Jon Kadlec and Dan Stara. Jon is in College four at St Gregory the Great and Dan is in the Propaedeutic (preparatory) year at St Gregory the Great. Meanwhile, back in Philly, Cody Hein is in his 3rd year of Theology and God willing will be ordained in December of 2026. We are very blessed to have three good young men from our David City parishes who are studying for the priesthood. Please keep them in your prayers.

We are blessed to have very solid education, and spiritual and human formation. I have heard lots of excellent reports from the young guys who have been in the propaedeutic year as well. They learn to unplug from all electronic and social media, develop their prayer life, study the Bible, read some classics, study the Catechism and get used to life in the seminary. They also develop good friendships, go on a poverty immersion and have traveled to Italy. I say, "what parent would not want their son to experience the propaedeutic year at SGG?"

Obviously, like college, seminary is expensive. The goal for 2025 is \$18,300 for St Mary's and \$1,300 for Assumption, Appleton. Given that we have three seminarians (3/31) benefiting from this formation, I'm glad the goals are not set on a pro rata basis. Please be generous to this worthy cause.

I had my cardioversion last Friday and was successfully shocked back into rhythm. Before that, they did a TEE where they probe down the esophagus with an echocardiogram and they found no blood clots. Monday, I had a PET scan (stress test) where they check for blockage in the main arteries etc. I got the results but don't fully understand how to read them, but they seem good. Fortunately, they did not call me for another surgery. Overall, I feel better without A fib. My energy is better and the side ache is gone for now.

Last Friday, after laying low following my procedure, I enjoyed going to the Magnificat celebration of Our Lady of Good Counsel Retreat House fundraiser. It was nice to see 250 people from across the diocese come out in support. Then Monday, I played in Catholic Social Services Annual golf tournament. Our team was 11 under which was pretty good and would have been better if we had sunk a 4 footer (but made some 20-30 footers). I feel blessed to be able to take in some of these events in our diocese with our proximity to Lincoln. God bless you all!


