Pastor's Corner

Dear St Mary's and Appleton Parishioners,

Just one thing on my mind and it is my nephew Patrick Connor, married to Olivia with a baby boy. I have nineteen nieces and nephews and they are all very special to me and I am sure you feel the same way about your family. Patrick had IGA nephropathy in his junior and senior year of High school. He was on dialysis and hoping

to get a kidney transplant. Fortunately his mother asked me at Thanksgiving in 2008 if I was still willing. I said sure. In the next week I had the blood test and was confirmed as a good match. In the springtime I donated my kidney to him while we were both at Children's Mercy KCMO (the nurse said I was her oldest patient ever 🙂). It was a smooth recovery for me (apart from the bumpy ride home from hospital and my dad finally got the painkillers picked up the next morning) and I was back in the parish for confirmation ten days later (but I had to take a nap). Patrick has been on antirejection meds as required and been taking very good care of his health. However, at Thanksgiving time he was not feeling well. He flew with his wife from NYC to LA to be with her family and has been for one week now at UCLA Hospital. His creatine has spiked from normal 1.2 to 4 and 4.5. I talk to his dad who said there are three possibilities. One, that the IGA Neuropathy is now attacking his new (my) kidney. Or that the kidney function is declining due to time. Or, that some other infection is affecting things (probably the best case). He said that Patrick is not able to speak on the phone for long. His wife is taking care of their son and experiencing all of this for the first time. His mother has flown out and she is good with doctors and getting answers. My brother will go out soon.

I ask you to please lift him up in your prayers. It is hard to know that he is so sick as a young father. This brother Keith lost his first wife in 2001 due to melanoma. Patrick was in sixth grade. Keith had twins who were in kindergarten at the time. Years later, while in college Andrew donated his kidney to Brian because he was a "stuck twin" in utero with twin-to-twin transfusion syndrome. Fortunately, no anti-rejection meds are necessary for Brian. So, my brother has 3/5 children with one kidney, and one bro. Keith was blessed to remarry a Catholic gal from Omaha who has been a great blessing to his family.

On another related subject, I am reading a very good book <u>Younger Next Year</u> by two doctors. I have learned a lot about the importance of exercise, eating right, sleep, and staying mentally and physically active. It is for anyone in their 60s, 70s or 80s or younger who want to get ahead of the curve on a healthy life.

Obviously, the spiritual life is central to feeling whole and holy. It was wonderful to see so many people at Mass on Monday, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. I think 99% of our Sunday people were there. How inspiring. God bless you all as we journey to Christmas. **FBC**
