

Appleton Assumption
Parish Council Meeting
August 3, 2020 7PM

Meeting was called to order by Father Buhman at 7:03 PM. Father Buhman led meeting with a prayer.
Roll call was taken.

PCCW Board – Lori Sabata, Nicole Sylvester, and Katrina Sabata

Reviewed minutes from last meeting. No changes were made.
Around \$14,000 in parish checking account at 6/30/20. Around \$13,300-\$13,400 as of today.

OLD BUSINESS –

Assumption Feast Day – Mass will be at 6pm on Saturday August 15th. Parish picnic following. There will be no Sunday mass. Council will provide pulled pork sandwiches from Didier's. PCCW will provide plates, utensils, salads and desserts. Valerian will provide picnic tables. Katrina will get announcement for mass and also have Heather put in the bulletin. Will order for 50 people.

Church Cleaning – Will take place August 11th at 6pm. Katrina will get announcement for mass and also have Heather put in the bulletin.

Roof – We got one bid from Tillotson Enterprises to do all the work for \$19,892. Jerome wrote up an estimate if we do it ourselves. Supplies estimated at approximately \$975 plus \$1,600 per week rental of a manlift truck. Fr. Buhman will write something up for someone to present it to the parish after a 9am mass towards the end of August.

Election of New Officers – Due to COVID, elections for new officers hasn't taken place yet. St. Mary's is hoping to have their elections in September. It was mentioned the first week after Labor Day is tentative plan to do voting.

NEW BUSINESS –

Fiscal Year End Reports – Our parish's year end was June 30th. Fr. Buhman is going to have some reports printed for the parish. Jerome suggested the reports also include the rental property.

Constitution & By-Laws – Fr. Buhman presented the Council with a draft of Assumption Parish Council's Constitution and By-Laws. Comments and suggestions were taken. Fr. Buhman is going to make some revisions and present another draft.

PCCW –

Deanery of Catholic Women – It will be Appleton's turn to have officers on the board. First, we need someone from our PCCW to serve as Vice-President for 2 years. Then the Vice-President will become President and will need two more people from our PCCW to serve as officers for 2 years.
